20 mins	Prepare Front Pages <ul style="list-style-type: none"> → Students should finalize the 3 stories they would like on their front pages. → They should each create a visual of their front page. It can be in powerpoint or another format → Each student will share their screen and explain their front page and why the stories were chosen 	✓
15 mins	Present Front Pages <ul style="list-style-type: none"> → Each student has up to one minute to show their front pages and why each story was chosen → The rest of the group can ask questions 	✓
15 mins	Simulation debrief <ul style="list-style-type: none"> → Before the simulation, how did you believe that stories were generated for a newspaper? → Why is the front page important for a newspaper? → What was it like to be assigned a story? → Were you interested in the topic you were assigned? If not, what was it like to work on a story that does not interest you? What are times at your school or at work when you have to work on something that does not interest you? → What was it like to work individually? When deciding how to present your story, did you take into account the other stories? How do you think this comes into play in an actual newsroom? → What was it like to make a final decision? What factors came into play as you made your final decision? → Did you select your own story? Why or why not? What did it feel like to select your story? What did it feel like to not select your own story? → What was it like for those of you whose stories were selected for the front page? How about those of you who did not receive a front page story? → As you compiled your stories, how did you balance the headline, the content, and the images? What was 	✓
